

**Thank You THCF... Our Year in Review:**

**In January** we purchased floor coverings and began meeting in the gymnasium. This allowed us to make seating comfortable due to growth.

**In February** we showed the movie “Fireproof” as an outreach effort. We had 68 visitors to the movie event.

**In March** we began serving monthly at the Refuge of Hope. Our Children’s church also expanded to more age appropriate offerings. We also joined the Movement Church for a joint service.

**In April** we provided a snack station at the YMCA’s Healthy Kid’s Day and held our Annual Easter Egg Hunt impacting more than 100 children.

**In June** we held our first Vacation Bible School and saw over 50 children attend and hear the Gospel message. We had OVER 30 volunteers help out.

**In August** we provided school supply backpacks and the Gospel of John to more than 80 children. We also provided a tote of supplies to the Fairless Elementary School.

**In September** we began a new series on rethinking “church”. Our Children’s Church expanded even more and our teen group began biweekly meetings. We also began a partnership with Eric and Amy Thoman and the Central Baptist Mission Center. Our Praise Team provided music and we provided pulled pork sandwiches, chips, and pop to over 150 inner city individuals.

**In October** we provided a bag of candy with a Gospel tract to 100 “trick or treaters” at the YMCA.

**In November** we provided 24 grocery and toiletry bags to include large turkeys to families. We also provided 13 roasted 20+ pound turkeys to the Movement Church partnering with Thrive Community Church of Green and Friendship Community Church of Canton. We also provided 8 frozen turkeys and a freezer to the Central Baptist Mission Center.

**In December** we adopted 20 families for Christmas to include over 180 gifts. We also provided gifts and a party at the Christian Children’s Home of Wooster where 42 foster children received gifts. We had 55 volunteers from THCF present for this event.
